July 8	Departure from Los Angeles airport.
July 9	Arrival Barcelona airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
July 10	Bus or boat tour Tossa de Mar: visit the beautiful old fishing town made
	famous in the 1950s by Ava Gardner and James Mason in the film Pandora
	and the Flying Dutchman. Evening game vs. a local team .
July 11	AM training session with your own coach's staff. After that visit Barcelona
,	by bus, covering the Bullring, the Gaudi buildings, Casa Battlló and the
	Pedrera, Plaza Francesc Masia, the Nou Camp - home of FC Barcelona,
	followed by Gaudi's unfinished Sagrada Familia Cathedral – we have
	included the admission fees into the participant prices - and lastly Parque
	Guell.
July 12	Visit the city of Girona. Sightseeing possibilities include St. Mary's Cathedral,
,	built between the 11th and 17th centuries, Passeig de la Muralla,
	Monastery of Saint Pere de Galligants and Chapel of Sant Nicolau, the
	Arab Baths, Cases de l'Onyar, etc. Evening game vs. a local team .
July 13	AM training session with your own coach's staff. After that visit the sacred
,	mountain-top monastery of Montserrat with its breathtaking views.
July 14	Free day in Barcelona visiting the places the bus cannot reach. Drop off
/	and pick up point in the central Plaza Catalunya. Recommended are the:
	Ramblas with its human statues and street artists, Palau de la Musica, Barrio
	Gotico with its maze of narrow streets, Plaza Real, and Cathedral. Evening

July 15	More sightseeing in Barcelona. Visit Montjuic, a prominent hill overlooking
55., .5	Barcelona with amazing views of the city and home to the Olympic facilities.
July 16	Transfer to Barcelona airport and return flight.

Sport program included:

We will arrange three games per team. We have included as well 2 training session with your own coaching staff.

Accommodation and meals included:

4-star Hotel accommodation in the Costa Brava region in a seaside town like Santa Susanna, Calella, etc.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- The accommodation is situated near the town center and/or beach. The distance to Barcelona is approx. 30-35 miles.
- Accommodation in rooms for 3 people (3 twin beds or a double bed and twin bed typically) and all rooms have a private bathroom, TV, phone, Wi-Fi access, and air conditioning.
- The hotel has a restaurant, bar, lounge, reception, and often a swimming pool.
- Double rooms (2 people per room) are available at a supplement of \$15.00 per person per night and single rooms (1 person per room) are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night.

Ground transportation included:

During your entire stay, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group 9-10 hours a day.

Local guide services included:

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.



Options available (not included in prices)

Sport program options:

- Training sessions with coaches from a Barcelona area pro club like RCD Espanyol

 costs approx. \$1,050.00 total per 2 hours, including field hire. Consult us for more information.
- Visit and tour of a pro team stadium and/or museum
 approx. \$ 35.00 per person for Camp Nou Museum and Immersive Stadium Tour (stadium under construction) or a tour of RCDE Stadium, home of RCD Espanyol.

Accommodation option Barcelona:

On request, we can accommodate the group in a 3-or-4-star hotel in Barcelona, close to the city center while in Spain instead. The hotel is within walking distance of a train station and near the Sagrada Familia. All rooms have private facilities/bathrooms, satellite TV, phone, and climate control. The hotel has a bar, lounge, workout room, and a small outdoor pool. The supplemental cost for this hotel option is approx. \$50.00 - \$85.00 or more per person per night (to be confirmed – depends on time of the year).

Travel insurance option:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

Not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to visit a pro game. Please notice that it is highly doubtful that any
 program will take place in the month of July because of the Summer break.
- Admission fees to attractions.



SIGHTSEEING IN BARCELONA

Recommended excursion(s) to pre-book are Nou Camp and Sagrada Familia.

1) CAMP NOU (Stadium under construction, museum only)

Price: ADULTS \$42.00 (Under 13's + Students \$33.00)

Visit the Home of Barcelona FC: the away team changing room, the players' tunnel, the dugouts, the press room, the commentators' box, and of course, the Museum. The Museum is the most modern football museum thanks to its interactive wall spaces, large-scale audiovisual displays, and an extensive display of objects to explain the history of FC Barcelona and understand the values that make Barça "més que un club" - " more than a club".

2) SAGRADA FAMILIA

Price: \$44.00 pp Fully Guided Group Tour (Includes a Tour Guide) – Does not include towers

The unfinished Cathedral by Gaudi, the expiatory church of La Sagrada Família, is a work on a grand scale that began on March 19, 1882, from a project by the diocesan architect, Francisco de Paula del Villar (1828-1901). At the end of 1883, Gaudí was commissioned to continue the work, a task which he did not abandon until his death in 1926. Since then, different architects have continued the work after his original idea. **Important note:** Once your group decides to pre-book this excursion, we do require an official letter from your club, school, or university. Please feel free to ask for a sample letter from us. Secondly, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to get admission tickets for this site.

3) MONTSERRAT MOUNTAINS

Price: Rack Railway Return Prices: Adult \$17.00 (Under 13s \$10.00), Santa Cova Funicular Return Prices: Adult \$15.00 (Child \$5.00) and Sant Joan Funicular Return Prices: Adult \$9.00 (Child \$9.00). Pre-booking is not available. Montserrat is a multi-peak mountain located near the city of Barcelona. It is well known as the site of the Benedictine abbey, Santa Maria de Montserrat, which hosts the Virgin of Montserrat sanctuary, which is identified by some with the location of the Holy Grail in Arthurian myth. The mountain is composed of a strikingly pink conglomerate, a form of sedimentary rock, and Montserrat is Spain's first National Park.

4) LA RAMBLA & BOQUERIA MARKET

Prices: Free

This busy street is just for pedestrians and is lined with outdoor markets, shops, restaurants, and cafes. La Boqueria is a large public market in the Ciutat Vella district of Barcelona, and one of the city's foremost tourist landmarks, with an entrance from La Rambla, near the Liceu, Barcelona's opera house. The market has a remarkably diverse selection of goods.

Prices and availability for these excursions may change at the time of booking.
