Travel dates:

July 28 – August 5, 2025

Itinerary:

- July 28 Departure from Dallas-Ft. Worth airport.
- July 29 Arrival Barcelona airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- July 30 Bus or boat tour Tossa de Mar: visit the beautiful old fishing town made famous in the 1950s by Ava Gardner and James Mason in the film Pandora and the Flying Dutchman. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- July 31 Visit Barcelona by bus, covering the Bullring, the Gaudi buildings, Casa Batlló and the Pedrera, Plaza Francesc Masia, followed by Gaudi's unfinished Sagrada Familia Cathedral, and lastly Parque Guell. **Training Session with a Barcelona area pro club coach.**
- August 1 Visit the city of Girona. Sightseeing possibilities include St. Mary's Cathedral, built between the 11th and 17th centuries, Passeig de la Muralla, Monastery of Saint Pere de Galligants and Chapel of Sant Nicolau, the Arab Baths, Cases de l'Onyar, etc. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- August 2 Visit the sacred mountain-top monastery of Montserrat with its breathtaking views. **Training Session with a Barcelona area pro club coach.**
- August 3 Free day in Barcelona visiting the places the bus cannot reach. Drop off and pick up point in the central Plaza Catalunya. Recommended are the: Ramblas with its human statues and street artists, Palau de la Musica, Barrio Gotico with its maze of narrow streets, Plaza Real, and Cathedral. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- August 4 **Immersive Museum tour at the Nou Camp - home of FC Barcelona.** Visit Montjuic, a prominent hill overlooking Barcelona with amazing views of the city and home to the Olympic facilities. **Training Session with a Barcelona area pro club coach.**
- August 5 Transfer to Barcelona airport and return flight.

Price inclusions:

- Round trip airfare, including airport taxes and fuel surcharges. Prices are always subject to the availability of flights and fares at the time of booking.
- Accommodation and meals as specified in this proposal – see below. Hotel options and room types (triples, doubles, etc.) are subject to availability at the time of tour booking.
- Ground transportation – see below.
- Costs for arranging the sport program – see below.
- Services of a local tour assistant – see below.
- Admission to the Sagrada Familia and the Nou Camp museum.

Sport program included:

- We will arrange 3 friendly games per team. Games will be arranged against Spanish teams of comparable level to the traveling teams. We have access to all levels of clubs in Spain, including youth pro academy teams.
- We will arrange 3 training sessions per team with youth coaches from Barcelona area pro clubs like Girona, RCD Espanyol, Jabac, etc.

Accommodation and meals included:

4-star Hotel accommodation in the Costa Brava region in the seaside town like Santa Susanna.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- The accommodation is situated near the town center and beach. The distance to Barcelona is approx. 30-35 miles.
- Accommodation in rooms and apartment for 3 and 4 people. All rooms and apartments have a private bathroom, TV, phone, free Wi-Fi, and air conditioning.
- The hotel has a buffet restaurant, bar, lounge, reception, and a swimming pool.
- Double rooms (2 people per room) are available at a supplement of \$18.00 per person per night and single rooms (1 person per room) are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night.

Ground transportation included:

During your entire stay, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group 9–10 hours a day.

Local guide services included:

Each team will have a local, bilingual tour manager assigned to be exclusively with that team full time each day during the stay in each destination to provide any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend the daily schedule as needed.

Sport program options:

- We can arrange tickets for pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually, ticket costs range from approx. \$75-\$150 or more per person depending on the game.
- A 2-hour training session with your own coaching staff – costs approx. \$300.00 per 2 hours.

Travel insurance option:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance. Costs start at \$110.00 per person. We can include as well the option Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.
