

California Magic 2010 Boys East Gothia Cup Tour Itinerary July 12th - July 21st, 2024

General information:

Skeleton Itinerary: This is a skeleton itinerary only. The definite day to day program will be discussed with you upon arrival. The organized playing times and dates of your games and/or clinics and receptions must be honored.

Banks: Please note that banks in Europe are usually closed at weekends. We strongly recommend that you do not utilize traveler checks but use any or all of the following – ATM / Debit Card, Euro pre-paid cards, Credit Cards and take cash. Please take enough funds to cover the first few days, as precious time is wasted if most of your group needs to access cash on arrival.

VERY IMPORTANT: Most countries now require travelers to have a passport that is valid more than 90 days after your trip return date. If your passport expires within 90 days of your trip return date you should apply for a new one ASAP.

Copies passports: We also strongly recommend that your group's coach or team manager collects copies of all travelers' passports and, where applicable, paper airline tickets, prior to departure in case of theft or loss.

Student ID: If your group is a student group, please ensure all your party, where applicable, bring their Student ID as this will access many discounts on entry to various attractions.

Entrances fees: Entrance fees, parking fees, unless otherwise stated, are not included.

Soccer balls: Soccer balls will only be provided for the games. Please bring your own soccer balls for training sessions and/or clinic sessions.

Check your tickets: Please ensure that you cross-reference your airline tickets with your itinerary as departure times and flight numbers may have been amended since your itinerary was forwarded to you, and, if in doubt, check with your airline directly.

Delay: In case of delay caused by flight or transport issues, please advise our Representative as soon as possible if any amendments are required, so they can adjust your arrangements wherever feasible. The contact information /phone number of this representative is included in the following itinerary in this document.

Availability of rooms: Most flights from the US to Europe will arrive between 6.00 – 11.00 a.m. European times. However, please note that most hotel bedrooms will only become available between 2.00 and 3.00 p.m., so it will not generally be possible to check into your hotel room as soon as you arrive at your destination. Your local Representative will suggest a light excursion to occupy your group until your rooms are prepared.

General Tour Information and Tour Preparation: Please review your <u>Tour Confirmation</u> again and our <u>Travel Guide</u> on our website. If problems arise during the tour, please liaise with your local Representative immediately.

Security deposit: Some accommodation may require a small security deposit to be paid on arrival. The security deposit is to be held only in the event of damage by your team to any of the accommodation's property. Upon check out, your deposit will be returned.

Seat belts: All passengers, according to the law, must always wear seat belts on all bus transportation when in Europe. Premier International Tours, its partners and suppliers will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury caused to anyone ignoring this regulation.

Ground transportation:

We have included airport transfers for parents, coaches and players on July 13th and July 21st. The Gothia Cup will offer free public transportation. Upon arrival at Gothenburg airport, there will be a Gothia Cup greeting center in the arrival hall. After retrieving your bags, the Gothia Cup Staff will direct you to the transportation (bus) to your accommodation. After arrival at your accommodation, please meet with the Gothia Cup staff member at your accommodation. During this meeting you will receive detailed information about mealtimes, the tournament game schedule, Gothia Cards, excursion options, etc. The Gothia Card will give you access to the City of Gothenburg public transportation system. This convenient transportation system will get you everywhere in relation to the tournament as well as the City of Gothenburg. We recommend that you download the Phone Application – <u>Reseplaneraren Västtrafik.</u> This app gives thorough instructions/directions on the correct bus/tram to get on.

Note: If your group is split up between schools (players and coaches) and hotels (parents), the Gothia Cup only arranges airport transfers for the players and coaches to/from the schools.

If people booked just extra Gothia Cards (parents that did not book hotel and/or air through PIT), these cards will be given to leader (manager of coach) that comes with the team to check them in at the school.

People not booking arrangements through Premier International Tours:

Please be aware that we cannot provide any transportation from or to the airport or for any prearranged group tour activities (sightseeing excursions, etc.) or any transportation arranged for the group for individuals which did not book the tour package with Premier International Tours. Because of liability/legal issues with our suppliers (Bus Company, etc.) people who booked their own flights and accommodation are not allowed to just join the group on bus transfers arranged for the group.

Guide services:

During the Gothia Cup tournament staff is available at your accommodation and the tournament information centers to assist you and your group.

Airline reservations:

Premier International Tours has partnered with Fly My Group who made all your airline's reservations. In case of any questions concerning your airline reservations <u>prior</u> to the tour please contact Premier International Tours. We request that only the group leader(s) call them and use the group ID number # 51226.



Check-in and Seat assignments:

We have emailed your group leader specific information regarding check-in procedures and seat assignments.

Information for flights in case of flight changes or cancellations:

Please note that your group is booked through the group departments of airlines under group fare guidelines and conditions. Many times, we must go through the group department of the airline to change flights for the group or individual passengers, etc. Therefore, please follow these guidelines regarding any flight cancellations or changes during the trip.

- In case of any flight delays that will cause a misconnect or any flights that are cancelled, always first work with an airline representative at the airport to fix the issue and get the group on other flights.
- If any individuals want to change flights (dates only, routing changes not permitted), then
 individuals should contact the airline first to see if the change can be made. If the change
 cannot be made by the airline, contact us and we will contact the airline group
 department and attempt to make the change. Please note that the group departments of
 airlines are closed at the weekends, so we have some limitations.

Laundry:

The Gothia Cup offers a laundry service for team jersey kits, and we have sent you a flyer including specific information for this service. Please reach out if you need this re-sent.

Gothia Cup facts:
