Sport program:

Participation in the MIC international tournament. The MIC features high level and well-known international soccer clubs like FC Barcelona, Real Madrid, RCD Espanyol (Spain), Liverpool FC, Manchester United (England), Inter Milan (Italy), Brazilian National Team, etc.



Important Note:

The MIC requires that all teams must have and pay for a minimum of 14 players registered in eleven-a-side categories and a minimum of 9 players in the seven-a-side categories.

Accommodation and meals:

Palamos or direct area: 3-or-4-star Hotel accommodation in the seaside holiday region of the Costa Brava.

- Daily breakfast, lunch, and dinner - first meal is dinner on April 15th and last meal is lunch April 20.
- The accommodation is located near the town center and/or beach in seaside holiday towns like Tossa de Mar, Palamos, and Sant Antoni de Calonge.
- Distance to Barcelona is approx. 50-70 miles. All rooms (2-3 people per room) have a shower and toilet as well as air conditioning.
- The hotel has a restaurant, bar, lounge, reception, and sometimes an outdoor swimming pool.
- Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$50.00 per person per night.

Transportation:

Airport transfers on April 14 and April 21 are included. From April 15-20, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – 10 hours a day and 250 kilometers max. driving distance per day.

Local guide services:

During your stay at the MIC, you can collect information or address any questions, issues, or concerns with the local tournament staff, who are available on a 24/7 basis during the tournament. MEDITERRANEAN INTERNATIONAL CUP (MIC) – PALAMOS/SPAIN

The Mediterranean International Cup will take place for the 24th time in 2025. Heart of the MIC tournament is the stadium of Palamós. Palamós is located at the northern end of a large bay, which is popular for swimming, sailing, and windsurfing. Distance to Barcelona is 70 miles. This tournament counts as one of the most competitive Spring tournaments in Europe.



MIC Facts:

Since the beginning, the MIC tournament has been supported by famous soccer people like Pep Guardiola, Luis Felipe Scolari, Ronaldo, Ronaldinho. Some past participants of the MIC have already made their debut with first division clubs like Leo Messi, (FC Barcelona), Cesc Fàbregas (Arsenal FC), Anderson (Manchester United), Lucas (Liverpool FC), and Marcelo (Real Madrid CF). All the finals of the MIC will be broadcasted by different National TV Channels.

Famous soccer clubs like Benfica (Portugal), Porto (Portugal), Sporting (Portugal), Sevilla (Spain), Valencia (Spain), Ferencvaros (Hungary), Liverpool (England), Paris St. Germain (France) and Vasco de Gama (Brazil) Zenit (Russia) will participate.

Touristic information:

- Sightseeing Rome. Visit the Colosseum, Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, the Arch of Constantine, the Palatine Hill, the most famous of the seven hills of Rome. Then, take a walk along the Via Sacra or 'Sacred Way', the main path through the Roman Forum that was used for triumphal processions, and visit the temple which houses the altar where Julius Caesar was cremated.
- Boat Trip in San Felice Circeo – this area offers a natural paradise with endless caves. It is the most fascinating itinerary of the Circeo National Park with about forty caves of particular beauty, the most important are the Grotta delle Capre, Grotta del Fossellone, Grotta dell'Impiso and many others. All are fascinating and rich in history.
- Miami Beach Acqua Park.
- Stadio Olimpico – This soccer stadium is the home of soccer clubs Lazio & Roma plus the venue for the Coppa Italia final & many international games.
