Travel dates:

July 11-20, 2025

Itinerary:

- July 11 Departure from LAX airport.
- July 12 Arrival Copenhagen airport. Transfer to your accommodation in Gothenburg.
- July 13 Day at leisure to explore Gothenburg.
- July 14 First day of games (group stage). Gothia Heden Center is open; Heden Center is an exhibition area where Gothia Cup partners arrange fun activities and competitions, including the official Gothia Cup Store. Gothia Opening Ceremony at Nya Ullevi; admission from 6:30 PM (free admission with Gothia Card).
- July 15 Group stage continues. Gothia Heden Center is open. Gothia Team Manager and Coaches Party at Scandinavium arena from 7:00 PM-12 AM.
- July 16 Last games of group stage. The playoffs start. Gothia Heden Center is open.
- July 17 A and B Playoffs continue. Gothia Heden Center is open.
- July 18 A and B Playoffs continue. Gothia Heden Center is open.
- July 19 Gothia Finals at Gamla Ullevi and SKF Arena from 8.30 AM. All B Playoffs are played at Heden starting at 08:00 AM.
- July 20 Transfer to Copenhagen airport for return flight.

Included:

Sweden: Participation in the Gothia Cup

Accommodation and meals included Option 1 (school accommodation):

Sweden: School accommodation in schools in Gothenburg.

- Daily breakfast will be served at the school, with daily lunch and dinner served at the tournament meal center. First meal: Evening dinner on Sunday, July 13, and last meal lunch on Saturday, July 19.
- Each team will receive one classroom for its own use. The Gothia Cup will arrange bedding for all participants. Bedding includes a mattress on the floor with a pillow, sheets, and a duvet/blanket. Schools have shared facilities and bathrooms by gender.



Accommodation and meals included Option 2 (hotel):

Hotel accommodation in a 4-star hotel in or just outside the center of Gothenburg. Includes accommodate in double rooms all with private bathroom, TV, telephone, parquet floor, mini bar, iron, trouser press, a kettle for tea and coffee, and a safe deposit box. The hotel has a lounge, bar, and restaurant or multiple restaurants. Some single rooms are available at a supplement of \$60.00 per person per night (\$480 total).

This hotel option includes daily breakfast only. The Gothia Cup offers a meal plan as well; self-service, cafeteria-type meals are served at the tournament center. Costs are approx. \$110.00 per person for 12 meals and \$75.00 per person for 6 meals (lunch or dinner).

Please note that if parents/families stay at the hotel and players/coaches at the school, only one airport transfer is included to the school. Parents can take a taxi from the school accommodation.

Travel insurance option:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including a Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

Ground transportation included:

All airport transfers are included. During the Gothia Cup, the tournament organizer can arrange special shuttle transportation. On free days during the tournament, we can arrange a private chartered bus for excursions (for an additional charge).

Local information services included:

During your stay at the Gothia Cup, you can collect information or address any questions or concerns with the local tournament staff, which is readily available. There will also be Premier International Tours staff on site to assist your group when necessary.

- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.

Tournament Information

GOTHIA CUP - GOTHENBURG/SWEDEN



Since its beginning in 1975, the Gothia Cup has grown to over 1,900 teams representing more than 80 countries. The opening ceremony at Ullevi Stadium attracts 50,000 spectators and participants, while 1,500 volunteers guarantee that this will remain the tournament of all tournaments! First-class competition on first-class fields is only part of this great festive week. Located on Sweden's beautiful west coast, Gothenburg offers all the excitement of a major seaport city, as well as fine beaches, water sports, boat trips, shopping, and dining. The 2025 Gothia Cup will again be the world's largest and most prestigious soccer party for both players and fans.

Gothia Cup facts:

- 1,600+ international youth soccer teams
- 40,000 participants from 80 different countries
- One of the highlights of the tournament is the Olympic-style opening ceremony which takes place in Ullevi Stadium, the home stadium of Swedish pro club IFK Göteborg, with 50,000+ spectators.
- Games take place on natural grass and turf fields at 30+ soccer complexes.
- Heden is the heart of the Gothia Cup. Here you will find the Central Information building, the tournament's headquarters, during the week.

Touristic information:

- Tradgaardsforening: the city park created in 1842 along the ancient city walls. A special place with beautiful gardens, sculptures, live music, and cafes.
- Liseberg: Scandinavia's largest amusement park right in the city centre; discounted entry for Gothia Cup participants.
- Gothenburg is surrounded by an archive of Islands. Make a trip along the coast to enjoy the view and spend a couple of hours on the beach.
- Canal tours – There are a number of companies offering canal tours around the city and harbor that are a great way to learn and explore Gothenburg.
- Avenin – The main boulevard in Gothenburg with historical monuments and lined with shops, restaurants, cafes, etc.
- Haga – Haga is a very traditional-looking neighborhood near the city center that will take you back to 17th-century Sweden, and there are no costs required.
