# DECEMBER 26, 2025 – JANUARY 3, 2026

- Dec. 26 Departure from Denver airport.
- Dec. 27 Arrival Barcelona airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- Dec. 28 Bus or boat tour Tossa de Mar: visit the beautiful old fishing town made famous in the 1950s by Ava Gardner and James Mason in the film Pandora and the Flying Dutchman. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Dec. 29 Training session with a coach from a Barcelona-area pro club like Espanyol. Visit Barcelona by bus, covering the Bullring, the Gaudí buildings, Casa Batlló and the Pedrera, Plaza Francesc Masia, the Nou Camp - home of FC Barcelona, followed by Gaudí's unfinished Sagrada Família Cathedral, and lastly Parque Guell.
- Dec. 30 Visit the city of Girona. Sightseeing possibilities include St. Mary's Cathedral, built between the 11th and 17th centuries, Passeig de la Muralla, Monastery of Saint Pere de Galligants and Chapel of Sant Nicolau, the Arab Baths, Cases de l'Onyar, etc. **Evening game vs. a local team.**

- Dec. 31 Visit the sacred mountain-top monastery of Montserrat with its breathtaking views.
- Jan. 1 Free day in Barcelona visiting the places the bus cannot reach. Drop off and pick up point in the central Plaza Catalunya. Recommended are the: Ramblas with its human statues and street artists, Palau de la Musica, Barrio Gotico with its maze of narrow streets, Plaza Real, and Cathedral. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Jan. 2 More sightseeing in Barcelona. Visit Montjuic, a prominent hill overlooking Barcelona with amazing views of the city and home to the Olympic facilities.
- Jan. 3 Transfer to Barcelona airport and return flight.

\* The above itinerary is a provisional/suggested itinerary and can/will change depending on your group's specific wishes, the final game schedule for your team(s), and any pro game visit(s) incorporated for your group. Sightseeing admission fees are not included in the prices but can be added and pre-booked based on your group's specific wishes. Consult us for more information.

### ROUND TRIP AIRFARE INCLUDED

Round trip airfare, including airport taxes and fuel surcharges. Prices are always subject to availability of flights and fares at the time of tour booking.



### SPORT PROGRAM INCLUDED:

We will arrange three friendly games per team. We will arrange one training session with a coach from a Barcelona-area pro club like Espanyol. We will arrange a pro-team stadium tour like Camp Nou, home of FC Barcelona.



### ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS INCLUDED:

**4-star Hotel accommodation in the Costa Brava region in a seaside town like Santa Susanna, Calella, etc.**

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- The accommodation is near the town center and/or beach. Distance to Barcelona is approx. 30-35 miles.
- The hotel has a restaurant, bar, lounge, reception, and often a swimming pool.
- Accommodation in rooms for 3 people (3 twin beds or a double bed and twin bed typically) and all rooms have a private bathroom, TV, phone, Wi-Fi access, and air conditioning. Double rooms (2 people per room) are available at a supplement of \$15.00 per person per night and single rooms (1 person per room) are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night.



### GROUND TRANSPORTATION INCLUDED:

During your entire stay, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – 10 hours a day.

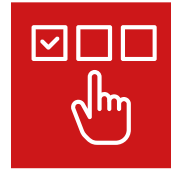


### LOCAL GUIDE SERVICES INCLUDED:

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full-time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

### NOT INCLUDED ARE:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.

### SPORT PROGRAM OPTIONS

We can arrange tickets for pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually, ticket costs range from approx. \$75-\$150 or more per person depending on the game.

A 2-hour training session with your own coaching staff – costs approx. \$300.00 per 2 hours.

Training sessions with coaches from a Barcelona area pro club like RCD Espanyol – costs approx. \$1,050.00 total per 2 hours, including field hire. Consult us for more information. Visit and tour of a pro team stadium and/or museum – approx. \$ 35.00 per person for Camp Nou Museum and Immersive Stadium Tour (stadium under construction) or a tour of RCDE Stadium, home of RCD Espanyol.

### ACCOMMODATION OPTION

We can accommodate the group in a 3-or-4-star hotel in Barcelona, close to the city center while in Spain instead. The hotel is within walking distance of a train station and near the Sagrada Familia. All rooms have private facilities/bathrooms, satellite TV, phone, and climate control. The hotel has a bar, lounge, workout room, and a small outdoor pool. The supplemental cost for this hotel option is approx. \$50.00 - \$85.00 or more per person per night (to be confirmed – depends on time of the year).



### TRAVEL INSURANCE OPTION:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

## CAMP NOU

(Stadium under construction, museum only)

**Price: Included**

Visit the Home of Barcelona FC: the away team changing room, the players' tunnel, the dugouts, the press room, the commentators' box, and of course, the Museum. The Museum is the most modern football museum thanks to its interactive wall spaces, large-scale audiovisual displays, and an extensive display of objects to explain the history of FC Barcelona and understand the values that make Barça "més que un club" - "more than a club".

## SAGRADA FAMILIA

**Price: \$44.00 pp Fully Guided Group Tour (Includes a Tour Guide) – Does not include towers**

The unfinished Cathedral by Gaudí, the expiatory church of La Sagrada Família, is a work on a grand scale that began on March 19, 1882, from a project by the diocesan architect, Francisco de Paula del Villar (1828-1901). At the end of 1883, Gaudí was commissioned to carry on the work, a task which he did not abandon until he died in 1926. Since then, different architects have continued the work after his original idea.

Montserrat is a multi-peak mountain located near the city of Barcelona. It is well known as the site of the Benedictine abbey, Santa Maria de Montserrat, which hosts the Virgin of Montserrat sanctuary and is identified by some with the location of the Holy Grail in Arthurian myth. The mountain is composed of a strikingly pink conglomerate, a form of sedimentary rock, and Montserrat is Spain's first National Park.



## LA RAMBLA & BOQUERIA MARKET

**Prices: Free**

This busy street is just for pedestrians and is lined with outdoor markets, shops, restaurants, and cafes. La Boqueria is a large public market in the Ciutat Vella district of Barcelona, and one of the city's foremost tourist landmarks, with an entrance from La Rambla, not far from the Liceu, Barcelona's opera house. The market has a very diverse selection of goods.
