

**International Soccer Tour 2025 Itinerary**  
**Helena Soccer**  
**England – London and Manchester area**

**Travel dates:**

July 9-19, 2025. Feel free to adjust the dates by some days.

**Itinerary:**

- July 9 Departure from Helena or Bozeman airport.
- July 10 Arrival London airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- July 11 Sightseeing London. Options include The Tower of London, The Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace, and The London Eye, with its spectacular views over London. **Afternoon or evening game vs. a local team.**
- July 12 Visit Hampton Court Palace and Windsor Castle. For almost 200 years, Hampton Court Palace was at the center of court life, politics, and national history. Windsor Castle is an official residence of The Queen and the largest occupied castle in the world.
- July 13 Enjoy the day sightseeing in London. Visit the Chelsea Village MegaShop and Stamford Bridge Stadium, Trafalgar Square and Covent Garden shopping precinct, Emirates and/or Wembley Stadium.  
**Evening game vs. a local team.**
- July 14 Spend your final day in London enjoying more sightseeing. Visit the British Museum, Kensington Palace, Hyde Park, Regents Park, the Chinatown neighborhood, and the Natural History Museum.
- July 15 Transfer to your accommodation in Manchester. En-route optional stop at St. George's Park (English FA national soccer center) or in Chester. Chester is a magical city over 2000 years old; it is the most completely walled city in Britain. Walk the walls – 2 miles of entirely walkable walls, studded with historic towers and a bird's eye view of the city center. Look over the other side of the wall for a view of the Welsh mountains in the distance. Afterward, you can head for the Roman Amphitheater and Chester Cathedral (14th-century church).
- July 16 Sightseeing Manchester. One of the most popular sights is the Old Trafford stadium, home of Manchester United, and the English National Football (Soccer) Museum. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- July 17 More sightseeing in Manchester. Some popular sights include the John Rylands Library, Royal Exchange Theater, Manchester Cathedral, as well as different neighborhoods filled with shops and restaurants.
- July 18 Sightseeing in Liverpool. See popular sights like Royal Albert Dock, and Liverpool Cathedral and/or do an optional stadium tour of Anfield, home of Liverpool FC. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- July 19 Transfer to London or Manchester airport. Return flight.

\*The above itinerary is a provisional/suggested itinerary and can/will change depending on your group's specific wishes, the final game schedule for your team(s), and any pro game visit(s) incorporated for your group. Sightseeing admission fees are not included in the prices but can be added and pre-booked based on your group's specific wishes. Consult us for more information.

### Sport program included:

**London:** we will arrange 2 games per team.

**Manchester:** we will arrange 2 games per team.

We also include one training session with a youth coach from a pro club in the London area or Manchester area.

### Accommodation and meals included:

**London:** 4-star Hotel accommodation in London.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- The hotel accommodation is on the outskirts of London about 15 miles from the city center.
- Accommodation in triple rooms (3 people – 1 double bed + 1 sofa bed). Rooms all have private bathrooms, phones, satellite TV, and free Wi-Fi.
- Double rooms are available at a supplement of \$15.00 per person per night and single rooms are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night.
- Please be aware that rooms in Europe are not as big as in the USA.
- The hotel offers a restaurant, lounge/bar, outdoor patio/garden, fitness center, and free Wi-Fi.

**Manchester area:** 3--star Hotel accommodation in the Liverpool/Manchester area.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel accommodation in Northwest England located between Manchester and Liverpool.
- Accommodation in triple rooms (3 people – 1 double bed + 1 sofa bed). Rooms all have private bathrooms, phones, satellite TV, and free Wi-Fi.
- Double rooms are available at a supplement of \$15.00 per person per night and single rooms are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night.
- Please be aware that rooms in Europe are not as big as in the USA.
- The hotel has a restaurant/lounge, indoor heated pool, sauna/solarium, and fitness center.

#### **Ground transportation included:**

During your entire stay, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – 10 hours a day.

#### **Local guide services included:**

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

#### **Options available (not included in prices)**

##### **Sport program options:**

- We can arrange training sessions with youth academy coaches from English pro clubs like Manchester City, Everton FC, Tottenham Hotspurs, or Fulham FC. Supplement for a 2-hour session, including field hire, is approx. \$650.00 total.
- Subject to availability we might be able to arrange training sessions with English FA coaches at St. George's Park, headquarters of the English FA, along with a tour of the facilities. Approx. supplement for a 2-hour session will be around \$800.00 total.
- We can arrange tickets for pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually, ticket costs range from approx. \$75.00-\$150.00 or more per person depending on the game.
- Visit and tour of a pro team stadium – between \$25.00 and \$30.00 per person.
- A 2-hour training session with your own coaching staff – costs \$260.00 per 2 hours.

##### **Travel insurance option:**

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including a Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

## **SIGHTSEEING IN LONDON**

Recommend excursion(s) to pre-book are any stadium tour and the London Eye.

### **1) LONDON STADIUM TOURS**

Price Wembley : Adults \$44.00 (16 and under \$29.00)

### **2) THE LONDON EYE**

Price: \$43.00 (15 and under \$36.00) Book online

The London Eye is a giant Ferris wheel on the South Bank of the River Thames in London, England. The entire structure is 35 meters (443 ft) tall, and the wheel has a diameter of 120 meters (394 ft). It is the tallest Ferris wheel in Europe, and includes a 30-minute rotation, Samsung interactive capsule guides, and entry to 4D cinema experience.

### **3) TOWER OF LONDON**

Price: \$53.00 (15 and under) \$27.00

The massive White Tower is a typical example of Norman military architecture, whose influence was felt throughout the kingdom. It was built on the Thames by William the Conqueror to protect London and assert his power. The Tower of London – an imposing fortress with many layers of history, which has become one of the symbols of royalty – was built around the White Tower.

### **4) WINDSOR CASTLE**

Prices: Adults \$44.00 Young person (18-24) \$29.00 (17 and under) \$25.00.

A visit to the Castle includes the State Apartments, St George's Chapel, and Queen Mary's Dolls' House. Windsor Castle is a royal residence at Windsor in the English county of Berkshire. The castle is notable for its long association with the British royal family and for its architecture.

### **6) LONDON DUNGEONS**

Prices: Adults \$52.00 (15 and under \$42.00)

The London Dungeon is a London tourist attraction which recreates various gory and macabre historical events in a gallows humor style aimed at younger audiences. It uses a mixture of live actors, special effects, and rides.

### **7) HARRY POTTER TOUR**

Prices: Adults \$81.00 (15 and under \$61.00)

People all over the world have been enchanted by the Harry Potter films for over a decade. The wonderful special effects and amazing creatures have made this iconic series beloved to both young and old – and now the doors are open for everyone at the studio where it first began.

### **2) NATIONAL FOOTBALL MUSEUM**

Price: Adult \$22.00, 15 and Under \$16.00

The National Football Museum is a museum at the Urbis building in Manchester city centre founded to preserve, conserve and interpret several important collections of association football memorabilia. The museum was originally situated in Deepdale, Preston, Lancashire, but moved to Manchester in 2012.

### **3) IMPERIAL WAR MUSEUM**

Price: Free

Visit the award-winning IWM North to discover powerful stories that reveal how war shapes lives, from a soldier's last letter home to the twisted steel of New York City's World Trade Center. Housed in Daniel Libeskind's iconic building representing a globe torn apart by conflict, IWM North offers a free day out like no other.

### **4) TRAFFORD CENTER**

Price: Free

The Trafford Centre is a largest indoor shopping center in Western Europe and leisure complex in Greater Manchester, England. Situated in the Metropolitan Borough of Trafford, the Centre is situated close to the Trafford Park industrial estate and lies approximately five miles west of Manchester city center.

### **5) THE BEATLES MUSEUM**

Price: Adult \$28.00, 16 and Under \$15.00

The Beatles Story is a visitor attraction dedicated to the 1960s pop group The Beatles in Liverpool, England.

### **6) JORVIK VIKING MUSEUM- YORK**
