- June 20 Departure from Los Angeles airport.
- June 21 Arrival at Lisbon airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- June 22 Sightseeing in Lisbon. Visit Old Town Lisbon, the historic heart of Lisbon, and see the Tower of Belem, Monument to the Discoveries, and Geronimo Monastery.
- June 23 Transfer to your accommodation in the Algarve region for the Challenge Cup. Evening opening ceremony.
- June 24 Start of Challenge Cup with group stage.
- June 25 Challenge Cup: Group stage and Playoffs.
- June 26 Challenge Cup: Playoffs. If eliminated, free day to visit the beach or local sightseeing or visit Aquatic (Water) Park.
- June 27 Challenge Cup Finals and awards ceremony.
- June 28 Transfer to Lisbon airport. Return flight.

Accommodation and meals included:

Lisbon: 4-star apartment hotel in the Lisbon area. Daily breakfast and dinner included.

- Hotel located on the outskirts of Lisbon approx. 10 miles from the airport.
- Accommodation in rooms for 3 people with private bathroom TV, phone, and Wi-Fi.
- The hotel has a reception area, restaurant and lounge, fitness center, and sometimes an outdoor pool.
- Double room supplements are available at a supplement of \$35.00 per person per night and single rooms are available at a supplement of \$65.00 per person per night.

Challenge Cup: 4-star apartment hotel in/near Lagos in the Algarve region. Daily breakfast, lunch, and dinner included.
